## Waste Reduction and Recycling Act 2011

### Proposed action for an end of waste code

*This notice is issued by the chief executive under s172(2) of the Waste Reduction and Recycling Act 2011 (WRR Act) to advise a registered resource producer of a proposed action for an end of waste (EOW) code.*

**Re: Proposed action to amend end of waste code ENEW07617019**

This Notice is issued to advise you that the department is proposing to amend the End of Waste Code ENEW07617019 for the reuse of abattoir effluent pond sludge and crust as a resource.

The reasons for the proposed action and the facts and circumstances that form the basis for the reasons are provided below.

The EOW code for Abattoir effluent pond sludge and crust was developed for the reuse of the sludge and crust generated in aerobic and anaerobic effluent ponds at a facility for the processing or rendering of meat or meat products. The current EOW code was developed following public consultation process during 16 February-16 March 2020.

In late 2021, the department received a proposal from Mark Rigby & Associates Environmental (MRA), on behalf of Tey's Australia, with supporting information, to amend the current code to remove the moisture content limitation specified in Requirement 6.3(b). Following review of the proposal, amendment of the current EOW code is now proposed to remove the moisture content limit while adding a transfer and transportation requirement.
