**Correction notice regarding
Minister's intention to appoint grantee**

This notice refers to the 'Notice of the Minister's intention to appoint' the Jabalbina Yalanji Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC ICN 7002 as grantee as published in the *Cairns Post* and *Townsville Bulletin* on **Wednesday 1 and Saturday 4 July 2020**, *Mareeba Express* on **Wednesday 8 July 2020**, *North Queensland Register* on **Thursday 9 July 2020** and *Palm Island Voice* on **Thursday 16 July 2020**.

Notice is given that the Minister for the Environment and the Great Barrier Reef and Minister for Science and Youth Affairs now intends to appoint **Jabalbina Yalanji Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC ICN 7002** as grantee of lot 11 on SP320133 and lot 4 on SP296954 to hold the land in trust for the benefit of Aboriginal people particularly concerned with the land, their ancestors and descendants, pursuant to section 40 *Aboriginal Land Act 1991*.

Notice is also given that the Minister for Environment and the Great Barrier Reef and Minister for Science and Youth Affairs retracts the grant of lot 900 on SP296959 as advertised, for proposed appointment of **Jabalbina Yalanji Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC ICN 7002** as grantee.
