# Return of Operations

## Section 165- Nature Conservation (Wildlife Management) Regulation 2006

### Wildlife farming licence

Nature Conservation Act 1992  
Nature Conservation (Administration) Regulation 2006  
Nature Conservation (Wildlife Management) Regulation 2006

A return must be submitted annually within 10 days of the anniversary date of the licence.  
A return must be submitted within 10 business days after the license ceases to have effect.  
A separate return must be submitted for each return period  
You must keep a copy of the completed return at the premises stated in the licence.
