Penalty Infringement Notices – Offence Codes

This document lists the offence codes that Department of Environment and Science (DES) officers will use when filling out a Penalty Infringement Notice (PIN) in relation to an alleged offence under the Coastal Protection and Management Act 1995 detailed below. The offence code field is one of the mandatory fields in the PIN. Please refer to the Procedural Guide Manual on PINs for further guidance concerning their issue. **Please ensure you have the most up to date version of this document, and reference to the relevant offence section in the relevant Act is ALWAYS required.**

ONLY USE THIS DOCUMENT FOR OFFENCES THAT HAVE OCCURRED BETWEEN 1 JULY 2020 AND 30 JUNE 2021

The current value of a penalty unit is \$133.45 for the financial year commencing 1 July 2020. The value of a penalty unit will continue to be indexed and will increase each financial year from the 1 July. The date of an offence determines the value of the penalty unit that must be applied. To calculate the penalty value, officers must multiply the penalty units for an offence by the penalty value at the time the offence occurred.

*Note: if there is no Ecotrack code listed in this document, officers should use the appropriate code by searching the legislation and section number in Ecotrack.
