

Planning controls for South East Queensland koala habitat

This information sheet provides a simple explanation of the new planning controls introduced to protect koala habitat in SEQ. The coloured areas on the infographic below represent different mapped areas (i.e. koala priority area, koala habitat area, key resource area and identified koala broad-hectare area). The numbers represent a proposed development. Table 1 describes the proposed development and the planning control that applies to the proposed development.
